Trailer Rental Agreement

This Trailer Rental Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into electronically between LoadUp Trailer & Equipment Rentals ("Owner," "we," "us") and the individual identified below ("Renter," "you") at the time of online booking and digital signature. By completing the booking process, uploading identification, and signing electronically, Renter agrees to all terms below.

1. Renter & rental information

Identification is collected and verified electronically at the time of booking. Renter represents that the information provided is accurate and that Renter is the person depicted in the uploaded identification.

3. Rental period, rates & fees

Rental begins at the date and time selected during online booking and ends at the scheduled return date and time unless extended in advance through the booking platform. The daily rental rate and any applicable delivery or cleaning fees are disclosed and charged at the time of booking. A refundable security deposit of \$250 applies to every rental.

- A refundable \$250 security deposit is authorized on Renter's payment method at booking and released after Owner confirms the trailer's return and condition.
- Rentals are billed by the day; partial days are billed as a full day unless otherwise stated at booking.
- Extensions must be requested and approved through the booking platform prior to the scheduled return time.

4. Self-service, keyless access & digital agreement

This is a self-service rental. Renter understands and agrees that:

- Trailer access is provided via a smart coupler lock or keypad that generates a one-time access code tied to the approved rental window.
- The access code is provided only after payment is confirmed and this Agreement is signed.
- Renter is solely responsible for safeguarding the access code and for properly relocking the trailer at the end of the rental.
- No Owner staff member is required to be present for pickup or return; Owner may nonetheless be present or available at its discretion.

5. Renter eligibility & towing requirements

- Renter must be at least 18 years of age and hold a valid, unexpired driver's license.
- Renter is solely responsible for confirming that the tow vehicle's hitch, ball mount, wiring, and gross combined weight rating (GCWR) are adequate and legally rated for the selected trailer and its intended load.
- Renter must ensure the trailer is properly coupled, safety chains are crossed and attached, and, where applicable, breakaway cables and lighting are connected before towing.

6. Permitted and prohibited use

The trailer may be used only for lawful purposes consistent with its designed function (flatbed hauling or dump/material hauling, as applicable). Renter shall not:

- Exceed the trailer's rated GVWR or payload capacity.
- Use the trailer off-road, in competitive events, or for any illegal purpose.
- Sublet, re-rent, or allow use by any person not listed on this Agreement.
- Remove, disable, or tamper with any GPS tracking device, lock, or safety equipment installed on the trailer.
- Transport hazardous materials, or loads that are not properly secured, tarped, or contained (for dump trailers, loaded beyond the rated capacity or with materials prohibited by local ordinance).

7. Condition, inspection & damage

Renter is responsible for visually inspecting the trailer, tires, lights, coupler, and safety chains before towing and documenting the trailer's condition through the booking platform at pickup. Any damage, mechanical issue, or missing component discovered after the rental begins that is not documented at pickup will be presumed to have occurred during the rental period. Renter is responsible for the cost of repair or replacement for any damage beyond normal wear and tear, and for professional cleaning if the trailer is returned soiled beyond normal use (particularly loose debris, concrete, or hazardous residue in the dump trailer).

8. Insurance

Renter is responsible for maintaining insurance coverage adequate to cover the trailer while in Renter's possession, whether through Renter's own personal or commercial auto/umbrella policy, a rider obtained through Owner at booking, or other coverage. Owner's rental of the trailer does not, by itself, provide insurance coverage to Renter, the tow vehicle, or any cargo.

9. Assumption of risk & limitation of liability

Renter assumes all risks associated with towing, loading, operating, and unloading the trailer. To the maximum extent permitted by law, Owner is not liable for any indirect, incidental, or consequential damages, or for injury, loss, or damage arising from Renter's use of the trailer, except to the extent caused by Owner's gross negligence or willful misconduct.

10. Indemnification

Renter agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Owner, its members, and agents from any claims, damages, fines, or liabilities arising out of Renter's use, misuse, or possession of the trailer during the rental period, including claims by third parties.

11. GPS monitoring & location data

Renter acknowledges that the trailer is equipped with a GPS tracking device that records location and movement data for security, geofencing, and recovery purposes. This data may be used by Owner to confirm timely return, investigate unauthorized use, or support recovery efforts in the event of theft or an overdue return.

12. Late return & recovery

A trailer not returned by the scheduled return time and not extended through the booking platform will incur a late fee per the rate schedule shown at booking. If a trailer is not returned or contact cannot be established within the timeframe disclosed at booking, Owner reserves the right to treat the trailer as unauthorized possession, use GPS location data to locate the trailer, and pursue recovery and all available remedies, including reporting to law enforcement.

13. Termination

Owner may immediately suspend access to the trailer or terminate this Agreement if Renter violates any term of this Agreement, including exceeding weight limits, unauthorized use, or failure to return the trailer as scheduled.

14. Governing law

This Agreement is governed by the laws of the State of Texas, without regard to its conflict of laws principles. Venue for any dispute shall lie in the county in which the trailer is based.

15. Electronic signature & acknowledgment

By checking the box and submitting this Agreement through the online booking platform, Renter agrees this constitutes a valid electronic signature under the Texas Uniform Electronic Transactions Act and confirms Renter has read, understood, and agrees to all terms of this Agreement.
